#### **Wraparound care**

The after school club provider continues from the end of the club until 5.30pm as a wraparound care package. If club numbers allow and there is staffing capacity, children will be given the option about joining the after school club or completing other activities.

These children will be served a light tea consisting of items such as wraps, beans on toast, sausage rolls, fruit etc.

## WRAPAROUND CARE AGREEMENT

### School will:

- Provide a safe and clear space to allow the clubs and care to take place
- Co-ordinate spaces to enable all clubs to be successful
- Provide cleaning for the wraparound care rooms
- Promote clubs through email and Class Dojo
- Share expertise regarding behaviour needs if requested and required
- Share information about the wraparound care in a timely and clear manner to support parents with preplanning
- Attempt to cover any absences of providers where possible to avoid disruption to parents working arrangements

### Parents will:

- Understand that a half termly commitment is required in payment to allow for the clubs to be successful. No refunds will be given for absence including COVID isolation.
- Understand that it is a first come first served basis and be aware of the dates shared on the communication for sign up
- Bring any concerns that they have to the provider, if these are unsolved they can bring these to the schools attention.
- Show respect and understanding to all adults they encounter.

### Pupils will:

- Demonstrate our 4 core values at all times; resilience, respect, compassion and curiosity.
- Show the same level of respect for the adults in charge of the clubs as they do for the school staff
- Try new things, take some risks and enjoy seeing themselves grow in new areas
- Remain with the club leader until an official handover is completed between the club leader and the parent.

### Providers will:

- Share with school the new clubs offer 5 weeks in advance of opening for the new term and clearly state booking arrangements.
- Hold a current DBS and relevant first aid certificate requirements and these will be shared with school.
- Provide school with any relevant risk assessments that they have taken for specific activities that require them
- Deal with any arising safeguarding concerns, but also alert school to these through emailing [DSL@kestrel-tmet.uk](mailto:DSL@kestrel-tmet.uk).
- Be prompt, prepared and follow our positive behaviour system in school showing respect to all children and adults at all times.
- Attempt to cover all absences from within their own company, if this is not possible they will give timely notice to the school to allow them to try and provide cover or cancel.
- Ensure that they leave the room in the state that they found it (school equipment away if used, no large pieces of food on the floor/lost property put into lost property store, own equipment stored securely if agreement made)
- Form an agreement with school about the resources school are providing and the resources that provider is providing.
- Give a minimum of 8 weeks notice if they cannot provide this offer to Kestrel Mead anymore.
- Provide school with a copy of their COVID RA if required under government guidance.
